Tuition

The following tuition schedule has been adopted for the 2018-2019 academic year. Tuition may be paid by (1) monthly payment beginning June 2, 2018, and continuing through May 2, 2019; (2) two payments – the first due June 2, 2018, and the second due November 2, 2018; or **(3) annual payment is due June 2, 2018, and will be discounted by 2%.** The first tuition payment is due June 2, 2018, for all payment plans. If payment is not received by June 10, 2018, Covenant will be released from the obligation to guarantee your child's space.

International Student Fee - \$2,500 per year

The monthly tuition payment amount listed on this schedule is the rate for payments that begin in June. If enrolling in July or August and choosing the monthly payment plan, the tuition for the missed months (June and/or July) plus month of enrollment must be paid in one lump sum to become current with the 12-month payment plan.

Advanced Placement Courses may be assessed textbook and testing fees. Non-consumable books and materials remain the property of Covenant. Special trips, student pictures, athletic fees, 5th – 12th grade field trips, and fellowship activities are not included in the fee schedule.

Covenant has designated funds for partial financial aid for each academic year. These funds will be awarded based on annual budget and financial need. Applications for financial assistance must be completed online. Go to www.covenantknights.org. Click on *Admission* then *Tuition and Fees*. Click on the FAST logo near the bottom of the page. Returning students must be re-enrolled prior to applying for financial assistance. New students may apply for tuition assistance once application has been made. All

applications will be held in strict confidence. Financial assistance award notifications will be made by the Business Office Manager.

The overhead expenses of the school do not diminish with the withdrawal of some students. Families accept the obligation to pay the published tuition rate and no portion of tuition paid up to the date of withdrawal will be returned for any student withdrawing from Covenant before the completion of the academic year.

Students who are not in compliance with financial, academic, disciplinary, state immunization requirements and school policies may be denied continued enrollment or placed on probation and subject to evaluation at the end of each grading period.
