REGISTRATION

Some class openings are limited to a specific number of students and age ranges. Registration for these classes is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Early registration is encouraged. Also, some classes require a minimum number of students in order to be offered. If the minimum number of registrations is not met, the class will be cancelled. Registration for the Spring semester enrichment program ends on **Wednesday, January 28**. You will receive confirmation of your child's enrollment via email when the class has met the required number of registrations.

- 1) All payments will be billed via FACTS and is due on or before the start of the second class.
- 2) Once class enrollment has been confirmed, your payment will be processed and must be paid via FACTS Parent Portal.

CANCELLATION POLICY
