Student Council

Description: The purpose of the Covenant student Council is to give students the opportunity to develop by organizing and carrying out school activities and service projects. In addition to planning events that contribute to school spirit and the community, the student council is the voice of the student body. Description: This program is designed to integrate student leaders in the admissions function of our school. Ambassadors will be called on to participate in an official capacity at special events throughout the school year such as open houses, new student events, campus tours and other outreach programs. Latin Club

Description: The Latin Club seeks to bring together students studying Latin at Covenant for the purpose of pursuing activities outside the classroom setting that promote, encourage and otherwise support all things Roman, especially those of the 1st centuries BC and CE. Students will enjoy the camaraderie of other students who have more than a mere passing interest in Roman language and culture. It will give students the opportunity to grow a deeper appreciation of the Latin language. Students will also have the opportunity to compete in the interschool statewide Latin competition in the spring.

Tech Club

Description: The Tech Club explores many topics related to computers, depending on student interest. Club activities include taking computers apart to examine how they function, fixing broken computers, coding, learning new programming languages, and much more.

Math Club (7th and 8th grade)

Description: The Math Club starts with a pre-qualifying exam taken in September. The top six math students from 7th and 8th grade will be in the math club (12 total). This club is designed to unify a broad group of students who encourage intellectual growth and promote mathematical awareness on campus and to the community. These students will also have the opportunity to compete against other students within the community to grow their skills and competitiveness.

Photography Club
