

SCHOOL ILLNESS POLICY

Please keep your child home from school if:

- × Your child has had diarrhea or been vomiting within the last 24 hours.
- ➤ Your child has had a fever of 100 degrees or higher within the last 24 hours.
- × Your child has been treated for strep throat within the last 24 hours.
- × Your child has a constant productive cough or continual runny nose.
- Your child has crusted or matted eyelashes, green, yellow or white sticky eye drainage and/or eye redness. These are symptoms of pink eye, which requires a doctor's treatment.
- **★** Your child has developed an unidentified or new rash.

Your child may return to school when:

- ✓ Your child has been fever free (temperature less than 100) for more than 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication (Tylenol, Motrin, Advil, or generic equivalents).
- ✓ Your child has been free of diarrhea and vomiting for at least 24 hours.
- ✓ Your child has seen a doctor for possible pink eye, and is receiving treatment; or your child has a note from their doctor stating they can return to school.
- ✓ Your child has been treated for strep throat for at least 24 hours and has been fever free without the use of fever reducing medication.
- ✓ Your child has seen a doctor for a new rash and has a doctor's note stating that they are receiving treatment and is cleared to return to school.
